
For organizations with access control systems

- SiPass Bewatel is a very cost-efficient alternative for up to four extensions
- SiPass Bewacom connects directly to a company's internal phone system, so no separate wiring is required!

SiPass Bewatel is an entrance phone unit that is only slightly larger than conventional codelock panel and available for 1-4 extensions.

- Ability to trigger CCTV recordings



How it works


- A door entry phone unit (BT41, BT44) or BTK41) is installed at the main entrance and up to four V801 telephone handsets at convenient locations inside the building
- When visitors arrive at the main door they simply press one of call buttons and the call goes through to one of the V801 handsets.
- The person at that extension then answers the call and if they want to allow the visitors into the building, they press "unlock" button on the V801 and the visitors are able to open the door.

For companies with internal phone systems



SiPass Bewacom is a door entry phone that connects directly to PABX internal phone systems, which makes it very cost-efficient.



Door entry phone for organizations with PABX


How it works

- SiPass Bewacom connects to a company's existing PABX internal telephone system in just the same way as any other extension in the internal network.
- As a result, the main entrance door can be unlocked via any of the telephone extensions that are connected to the company's internal telephone system.
- Installation is fast and easy with minimal cabling required.




Application examples

- The most common application is an office building that installs a BM3 or BM31 outside its main entrance door
- Another option is to install Bewacom devices at multiple locations: at the main entrance, at the loading dock, at the entrance to the underground parking area, etc.

SiPass Door Entry Phones – Integration with video surveillance

- Both SiPass Bewatel and SiPass Bewacom have an output for camera control.
- Either system can trigger a camera to start filming as soon as a visitor pushes a call button on the door entry phone, for example.
- Camera output can be viewed on a connected monitor directly by the person who picks up the call.
- Alternatively, the recording can simply be saved in the video surveillance log and viewed later, if required.
